1995

September—Send out first IAQ survey to Local 212 members

1996

May—Tabulate results of IAQ survey and send summary to union

September—Publish results of survey in Local 212 newsletter

1997

March—First meeting with MATC administration

May—IAQ walkthrough inspection by Milwaukee Health Dept.

September—Send out IAQ fact sheet and air quality and health checklist

1998

January—Submit AFT grant proposal to deal with IAQ issues

May—Receive AFT grant notification; IAQ walkthrough of printing area by UW-Extension

July—IAQ walkthrough inspection by Jonathan Rosen of AFT

Fall—Establish joint IAQ committee and begin regular meetings

1999

January—Adopt EPA's Tools for Schools action plan

March—Distribute faculty and staff IAQ checklists

April—Release of Indoor Environmental Quality Report by Jonathan Rosen

May—IAQ Open Forum with Jonathan Rosen

June—Letter from Dr. Birkholz endorsing IAQ work

September—Receive release time for IAQ assignment

October—IAQ class with Kay Rowntree of Industrial Hygiene Solutions; submit final AFT grant report
